Each year, the Board of Directors takes great pains to decide the show for our big Winter production. This year was no different. We read scripts, talked, debated, voted – AND – the winner was Kinky Boots. This musical won every major best musical award including the Tony, the Grammy and London's Olivier Award. Cyndi Lauper, who wrote the music for our show, was the first woman to win a Tony Award on her own.

Kinky Boots is based on the true story of Steve Pateman who tried to save his family-run W.J. Brooks Shoe Company in Earls Barton Northamptonshire, England by creating women's shoes for men. The musical tells the story of two people who think that they have nothing in common. Charlie owns the failing shoe factory. Lola has a crazy idea about boots. By the end of the show, their greatest achievement is not the boots that they create, but rather the wonderful friendship that they form.


